COMMUNITY ACCREDITATION

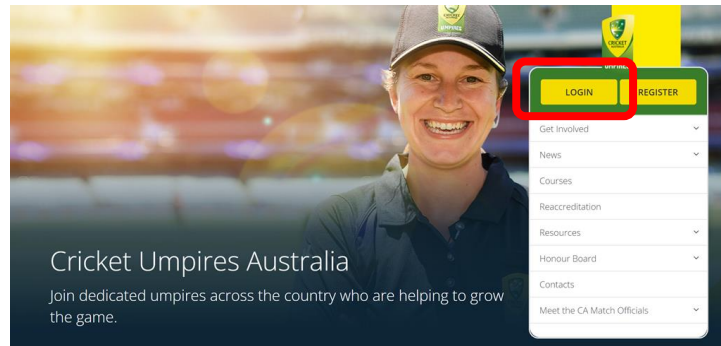
The Community Officiating program is designed to engage and educate new officials and is appropriate for both experienced and novice participants, regardless of whether they have previous playing experience or not.

Getting Started

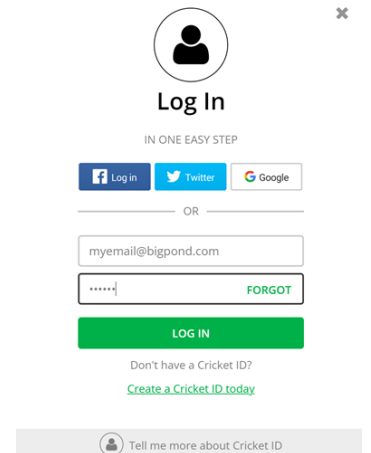
Step 1

To begin the reaccreditation process, visit <https://www.community.cricket.com.au/umpire> and click the 'log in' button



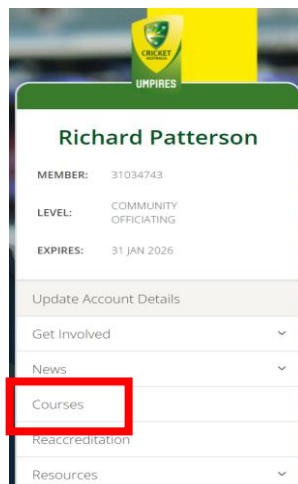
Step 2

- Enter your **email address and Password**

Click on 'Explore Courses' – please note that it takes approx. 45 seconds to enter the Learning Management System.

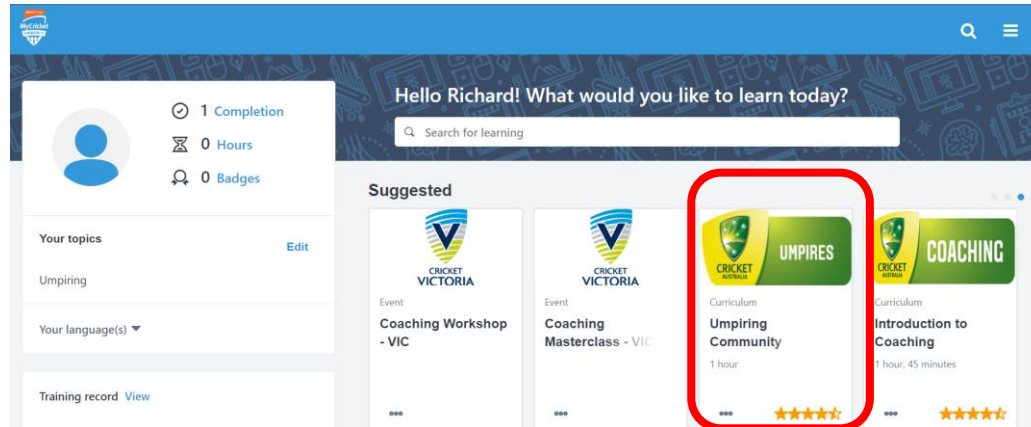

The Community Accreditation program can be located on your Learning Management home page.

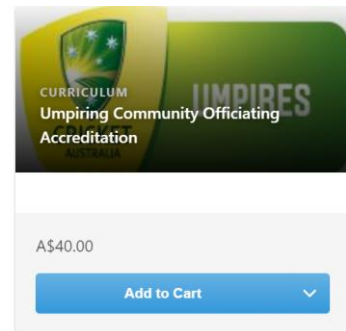
Click on the course and you will be taken the curriculum page.

Please note that payment is made through PayPal as a guest. You do not need to have a PayPal account.

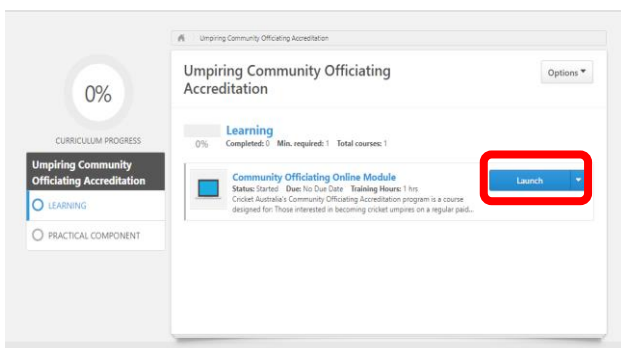


Step 7

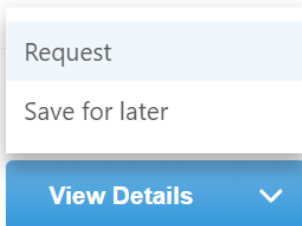
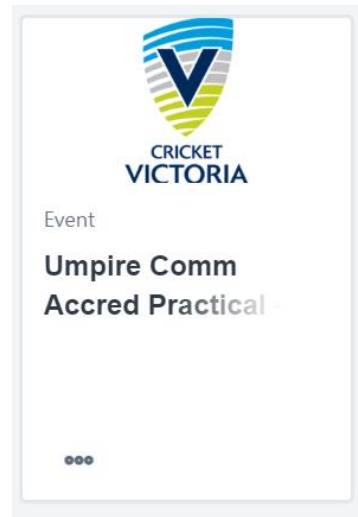
What's next?
